Procedure

Officer will perform physical exertion before firing. With the pistol loaded and secured in the holster and hands in a interview stance position when whistle sounds or command given, officer will draw and fire two rounds into the Preferred area of the target officer will then perform a Combat/Rapid Reload and then fire an additional two more rounds into the Preferred area of the target. Officer will hold on target and scan until command is given to holster.

Officer will hold on target and scan until command is given to holster.

Procedure

Officer will perform physical exertion before firing. With the pistol loaded and secured in the holster and hands in a interview stance position when whistle sounds or command given, officer will draw and fire four rounds into the Preferred area of the target with the strong hand only. Officer will then transition weapon to their support hand and fire four more rounds with the support hand only into the Preferred area of the target. Officer will hold on target and scan until command is given to holster.

Procedure

Officer will perform physical exertion before firing. With the pistol loaded and held in the chest ready positions when whistle sounds or command given, officer will assume position of choice I.E. Standing, Kneeling or Prone and fire six rounds into the Preferred area of the target. Officer will hold on target and scan until command is given to holster.

Procedure

Officer will perform physical exertion before firing. With the pistol loaded and secured in the holster and hands in a interview stance position when whistle sounds or command given, officer will move forward and draw their weapon and fire one round into the Preferred area of each target for a total of six rounds moving forward for a total of two rounds per target. Once officer is within six feet of the center target officer will then move backwards and again fire one round into each target for a total of 6 rounds, for a total of twos rounds per target for a combined total of 12 rounds. Officer will hold on target and scan until command is given to holster.

Procedure

Officer will perform physical exertion before firing. With the pistol loaded and secured in the holster and hands in a interview stance position when whistle sounds or command given, officer will draw and fire two rounds per target in the preferred area while moving parallel from the target going from Left to Right for a total of 6 rounds. Once the officer has passed the last target they will then stop and then move parallel from Right to Left again firing two rounds per target for a total of 6 rounds in the Preferred area of the target . After officer passes the last target the officer will scan until command is given to holster.

| Distance | 21 Feet | Officer must have at least 75% of body behind the protective cover or this will be considered an automatic failure. |
| Time Limit | 30 Seconds | |

| Mode of Carry | Chest ready | No alibi's will be given time is factored in to deal with malfunctions or reloads. |
| Hand Position | Not Applicable | |
| Physical Exertion | Run 20 yards | 3 targets may be used if 4 are not available by firing on the center target twice. Rounds that hit the line of the Preferred area are considered a miss |

Procedure

Officer will perform physical exertion before firing. With the pistol loaded and secured in the holster and hands in the interview stance position when whistle sounds or command given, officer will draw weapon and slice the pie while using the drop out technique fire two rounds on the outer most target on the right side of protective cover then repeat the process and fire two more rounds to the inner most target. Officer will then switch to the left side of the protective cover and repeat the process. All rounds must be in the Preferred area of the targets. Officer will hold on target and scan until command is given to holster.

| Rounds | 6 Service power minimum | No alibi's will be given |
| Distance | Start at one arms length moving up to 10 feet backwards | time is factored in to deal with malfunctions or reloads. |
| Time Limit | 16 Seconds | Officers are to make sure support hand does not get in front of the muzzle when firing from the hip |
| Light Conditions | Outdoor Ambient | |
| Mode of Carry | Holstered | |
| Hand Position | Interview Stance | Rounds that hit the line of the Preferred area are considered a miss |
| Physical Exertion | Run 20 yards | |

Procedure

Officer will perform physical exertion before firing. With the pistol loaded and secured in the holster and hands in a interview stance position when whistle sounds or command given, officer will draw and fire total 6 rounds while moving backward and creating distance into the Preferred area of the target. First two rounds fired will be from the half hip position the next two from chest ready and final two will be from the full extended position. Officer will hold on target and scan until command is given to holster.
